



# 2009 DEER HARVEST

## Harvest Standards

1. The HOA President will be Agent for all participating property owners.
2. Owners of designated harvesting areas will have the CCR provision against hunting temporarily waived for the purpose of implementing the recommended harvest.
3. Only persons issued Harvest Permits are authorized to harvest deer in Land's End.
4. Each harvester is assigned a designated area and safe firing zone.
5. Texas laws and these rules, restrictions and conditions must be obeyed at all times.
6. **SAFETY of persons, pets and property are our foremost concern.**
7. All shots must be taken from elevated positions in a downward direction towards the ground.
8. NO SHOTS may be taken towards homes, boat houses, the lake, roads or golf course.
9. Harvester is responsible and liable for any damage resulting from his actions.
10. Only firearms with center-fire ammo are permitted – no archery, crossbows or muzzle-loaders.
11. Take only good shots from short distances when confident of a clean, humane kill. Head shots are preferred. We do not want wounded deer in the community.
12. Harvester must have in possession a valid Texas hunting license with a buck deer tag attached, a Land's End Harvest Permit & a cell phone with the number provided.
13. Only white-tailed deer may be harvested as specified below:
  - Adult antlerless deer without any spots = Does. (Limit 2 with Land's End Permit)
  - A Buck deer having at least one hardened, unbranched antler protruding through skin. (Limit = your # of buck tags) *Bucks with branches on both antlers are prohibited, even if they meet legal requirements for inside spread of 13" or more. DO NOT take unauthorized deer.*
14. **It is ILLEGAL to take ANY deer in Land's End without checking-in, no exceptions.**
15. All harvested deer must be retrieved and transported intact to the check-in station.
16. Check-in is located at the green building in the open field behind the fire station.
17. At check-in, each deer will be weighed, aged, measured and tagged. It will then be field dressed and weighed again. We will dispose of field dressings.
18. All deer harvested must be retained for human consumption.
19. Permit is tentatively valid 11/7/09 – 1/3/10, however, it will be revoked when all Land's End HOA doe tags have been issued. Harvester will be notified of revocation via the cell phone.
20. Every attempt will be made to complete the entire harvest before Thanksgiving.
