All purchase, installation, setting, retrieval, storage and repair of the flags will be the responsibility of the Lake Fork Rotary Club.

This is a long term program and will add beauty and value to your neighborhood for many years to come.

Flag holidays are designated as:

1. Memorial Day – ~~Last Monday of May~~ *May 28*
2. Flag Day – June 14
3. Independence Day – July 4
4. Labor Day – First Monday of September *SEPT. 3*
5. Veteran's Day – November 11
6. President's Day – 3rd Monday of February – *FEB 19*

How does the program work?

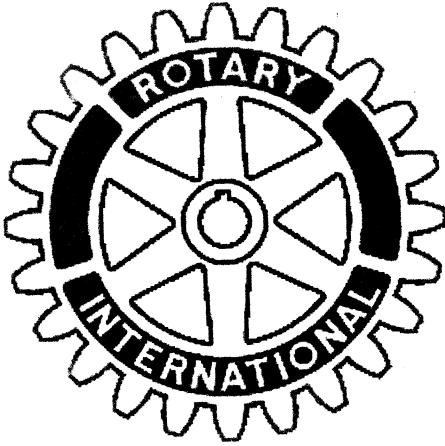
Volunteers will drive a one-inch diameter steel pipe in the ground near the street. The pipe will remain in place and will be used to hold the flag pole. The flags will be installed a day or two before the holiday and removed after the holiday. All work will be done by Rotary members and volunteer helpers.

How do I join?

Participation in the program requires an annual fee of \$30.00. These flags are high quality sewn (not printed) flags with long lasting poles. You will be pleased to have participated in this program and will enjoy the beautiful sight on holidays.
